The band raised enough money to build this wonderful facility through the generous donations of the public and by their fundraising efforts at every concert over a series of years. The James Center for the Performing Arts was designed and built by the Sequim City Band in 2004. In 2005, the facility was gifted to the City of Sequim.

This state-of-the-art facility boasts a 55' X 40' stage for a variety of entertainment purposes, including music, theatre, and dance productions. There are ample electrical outlets to support the performers.

The audience enjoys a park setting and a grassy area for viewing performances. Visitors can bring chairs or a blanket, or utilize the park benches on the perimeter of the grass donated by Sequim citizens for this specific use.
