### DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE FILE/SEP16-012

The City of Sequim has completed an environmental analysis, including review of pertinent and available environmental information and preparation of an Environmental Checklist for the following proposal:

**DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL:** This proposal is to update the City's development regulations, stormwater management regulations and enforcement chapters of the Sequim Municipal Code (SMC) to amend conflicting, confusing, out of date, or inconsistent code language. The updates allow the SMC to be streamlined. The majority of suggested changes related to stormwater management are found in SMC 13.104 and 13.108. However, enforcement subsections in these two chapters have not been revised.

The proposed revisions to the following sections of the Sequim Municipal Code (SMC).

- Section 8.36.042 – Adds Stormwater Manual to compliance requirement
- Section 18.80.070 – Adds references to Stormwater Management 13.104 and Stormwater Maintenance 13.108
- Section 13.40.010 – Revisions to Connections Required
- Section 13.64 – Removes Storm Drainage chapter
- Section 13.104 – Revisions to Stormwater Management
- Section 13.108 – Revisions to Stormwater Maintenance

The City Council will hold a Public Hearing at a future date. Any person has the right to comment on the proposal on or before the

Public Hearing, receive notice of and participate in any hearing, request a copy of the decision once made, and any appeal the decision.

**APPEAL PERIOD**

Any person wishing to appeal this determination may file such an appeal within **twenty-one (21)** days of the plan adoption by City Council. The appeal is to the Dept. of Community Development, located at 152 West Cedar Street. Appeals shall be filed pursuant to SMC 20.01.240. **THERE IS A \$550.00 FEE TO APPEAL THIS DETERMINATION.**
