<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Take I-5 S 2. At Exit 104, take ramp right for US-101 North toward Aberdeen / Port Angele 3. Keep right to stay on US-101 4. Pass 76 on the right in 1.8 mi 5. Keep right onto US-101 W / E Front St 6. Turn left onto N Peabody 7. Road name changes to S Peabody St 8. Turn right onto E 4th St 9. Arrive at E 4th St
