- Have more demos Natalie and Jake will create a timeline that includes duties and budget. This will be reviewed at the next meeting.

Habitat had agreed to give the Arts Commission a percentage of the proceeds from the beer/wine sales at Music in the Park and the Block Party. Karen will check to see if we ever received any monies from them.
