CALL TO ORDER

The City Council of the City of Sequim, Washington, met virtually using videoconferencing and teleconferencing on Sunday, January 31, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 6:01 p.m., with Mayor William Armacost presiding. The meeting was quorate.

ROLL CALL

City Clerk Sara McMillon conducted roll call. Mayor Armacost, Deputy Mayor Tom Ferrell and Councilors Sarah Kincaid, Mike Pence, Brandon Janisse and Keith Larkin were present. City Manager Charlie Bush also was present.

DISCUSSION OF INTERIM CITY MANAGER


Mayor Armacost said he is in the process of negotiating a contract for Interim City Manager services with Acting City Manager Charisse Deschenes. He said this special meeting was called to discuss Ms. Deschenes' employment with the rest of the Council.

At 6:04 p.m., Mayor Armacost called an executive session pursuant to RCW 42.30.110(g), to evaluate the qualifications of an applicant for public employment or to review the performance of a public employee. He announced the executive session would be one hour in duration. The Council came out of executive session at 7:04 p.m.

Mayor Armacost said negotiations with Ms. Deschenes will continue, and he anticipates an employment contract will be presented at the next regular City Council meeting.
