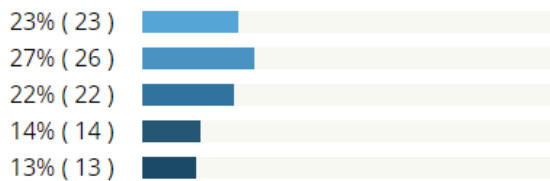

### Registered Voters in Sequim, WA (98)

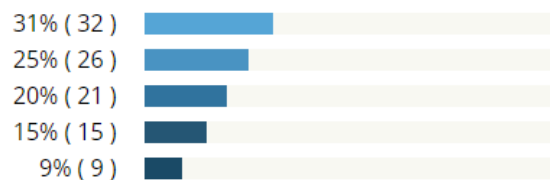


## How important do you think the private sector's role is in providing affordable housing?

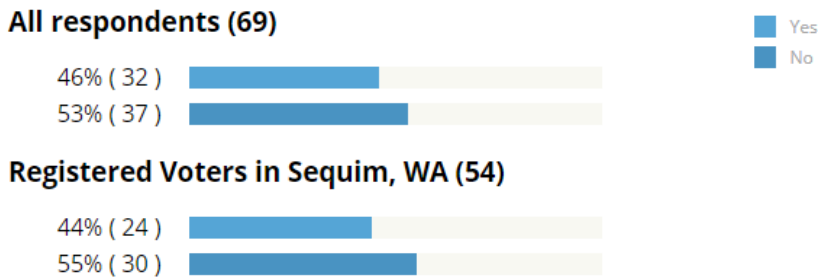

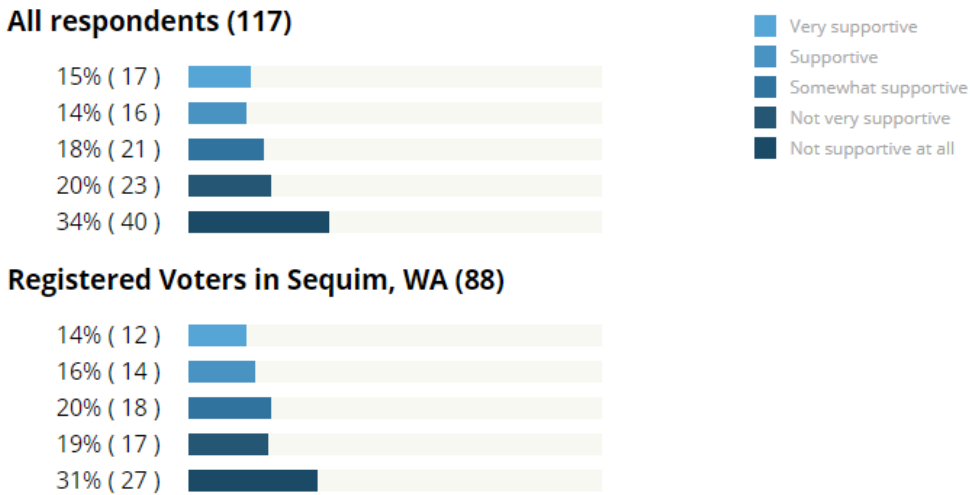
