Whereas, the City and The District concur that the timely completion of the North Sequim Avenue electric line relocation project is in the best interest of the community; and

Whereas, the City has issued a request for bids entitled "Specifications, Proposal, and Contract for: North Sequim Avenue Improvement"; and

Whereas the City has awarded the contract for North Sequim Avenue Improvements to Lakeside Industries, of Port Angeles, Washington; and

Whereas, Part 10 of the contract for North Sequim Avenue Improvements is the specifications for Electrical Undergrounding as provided by the District; and

Whereas, the laws of the State of Washington, specifically RCW 54.16.090, contains language governing contracts with other agencies.

Now, therefore it is agreed between the parties as follows:

- 1. The City will contract for the installation of underground electric distribution facilities as part of their North Sequim Avenue Improvement project.
- 2. The Parties have agreed on the District's and City's share of the project as described in the "North Sequim Avenue Reconstruction/UG Conversion" itemization attached to this document. The total estimated cost of this project is approximately \$338,679.00
 - a) The Public Utility District's fair share of the North Sequim Avenue utility undergrounding will be in the amount of \$142,000.00.
 - b) The City's fair share of the North Sequim Avenue utility undergrounding will be in the amount of \$196,679.00, an estimated cost until the project is finaled.
- The District will be responsible for inspections and have the final authority to approve the work associated with the installation of PUD #1 utilities within the North Sequim Avenue Improvement project.
- 4. The Parties agree that the District will own and maintain all electric distribution facilities upon satisfactory completion of the job. Lighting fixtures are not part of the distribution system and are addressed under a separate agreement between the District and City.
- 5. Each party warrants that the undersigned representative has full and complete legal authority to sign for it and to commit it to the performance of the agreements set forth herein.
